JSYT Grant Program

The Jersey Shore Youth Sailing Team has established a grant program wherein youth sailors can apply for funds to support their training and competition efforts. Grants will only be considered for training and competing in national and international events. The US SAILING ladder events are excluded since other grants available locally support competition in these events. Annual funding for the grants cannot exceed the income on JSYT's endowment. \$500 is the maximum grant per person per year.

Who may apply:

- residents of Monmouth or Ocean County, New Jersey
- Monmouth and Ocean County, New Jersey sailing club members
- youth sailors between the ages of 15 and 21 inclusive meeting one or more of the criteria above

What are the grant award criteria? Grants will be awarded based on the following general criteria:

- event prestige
- probability of success
- perceived need (financial information should not be provided)
- Note: grants will not be awarded for Optimist training/competition

When do I apply?

- grants will be considered twice per year
- Application deadlines are May 15 and October 15
- award notification will occur three weeks after the application deadline
- incomplete applications will be disregarded
